## WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

- All pieces of your performance attire (dress, shoes, socks, etc.)
- Everything you need to perform (reeds, rosin, strings, music, mallets, rock stops, valve oil, etc)
- Casual clothes for Disneyland. **Must comply with district dress code!**
- Sun protection.
- A jacket or sweater.
- Money for snacks and/or souvenirs. \$20 recommended. Each student will receive a meal voucher good for one meal in the park.
- Cell phones, cameras and iPods can be brought *at your own risk*. We will be able to leave items on the bus while we are at Disneyland.

## DISNEYLAND EXPECTATIONS

Band, orchestra, and jazz band will be assigned to groups of 4-6. Once we arrive at Disneyland students will be able to freely enjoy their time at the park, while remaining in their self-selected assigned student group. Students are never to be alone – ever.

Some basic expectations for every student:

- Students must be in groups of four or more CPMA students *at all times*.
- Students must check-in with chaperones at designated times.
- Students are representatives of CPMA Middle School and will follow all school rules and demonstrate Panther Path Core Values of Respect, Responsibility, Integrity, Caring and Trust *at all times*.
- Have fun and make good choices!

## WHAT IF MY FAMILY WANTS TO COME?

Family members are invited to attend the festival, awards ceremony and join us for a day of fun at Disneyland. We have limited space on the bus, so any family that is attending (outside of those chaperones riding with us on the bus) must provide their own transportation. Group rate tickets are available for \$62 at the performance locations. Parking at Disneyland is \$12 per vehicle. All students will be required to travel to Disneyland on the chartered bus.
